

## **Board Skills Audit**

## What is a board skills audit?

A skills audit is a self-assessment exercise for your board to highlight what each trustee brings to a committee, and identify any gaps in ability and knowledge on your board. It may be useful when pinpointing areas for your board to improve, when it is looking to recruit new members, or during the induction process for a new trustee.

## How to use this document.

Each member of the board should fill out their own skills audit sheet, rating their expertise in the given areas out of 5. Afterwards, the board then takes an average score for each skill to determine the board's overall proficiency in that area. In some cases, a board may only require one or two experts in a given subject, so a maximum score column has been added to record the highest level of expertise recorded by a board trustee. Space has been left at the end for a board to include any areas of expertise not included by this worksheet.

On a scale of 1-5, please rate the level of expertise you feel like you bring to your board.
